a certain lot or parcel of land together with the buildings thereon situated in Bath, in the County of Sagadahoc and State of Maine and bounded and described as follows, viz: the west half of a brick building and the land upon which it stands situated on the northerly side of Linden Street, in said Bath, and bounded on the east by land formerly of Charles H. Eugley; on the north by land formerly of Alden M. Potter; and on the west by land formerly of Estelle Hogan; and on the south by Linden Street.

Meaning and intending to convey herein all its right, title and interest in and to the abovescribed premises by virtue of a deed from Arthur J. Dunton, Administrator of the Estate of Frances A. Weeks to the grantor, dated September 2, 1936 and recorded in the Registry of Deeds for Sagadahoc County in Book 196, Page 325, and also a Warranty deed from Eveleth W. Safford to the grantor, dated September 3, 1940 and recorded in the Registry of Deeds for Sagadahoc County in Book 197, Page 184.

On here and in hold the aforegranted and bargained premises, with all the privileges and appurtenances thereof, to the said Bessie G. Singer, Her heirs and assigns, to her and their use and behoof forever. And the said Grantor Corporation does hereby covenant with the said Grantee her heirs and assigns, that it is lawfully seized in fee of the premises; that they are free of all incumbrances;
