To all Chapter Presidents and Treasurers:

We turn to you for help. Please do not send us personal checks made out by individual Jewish National Fund contributors.

In accordance with the procedure outlined in the Hadassah Manual, all individual contributions to a chapter, whether by cash or check, are to be deposited in the chapter's bank account. One check should be forwarded by the chapter to the national office to cover the sum total of all individual contributions. When you send us an individual check of this sort it means that we are handling an unduly large number of checks. But beyond that we find frequently that some of these individual checks are returned to us by the bank because of errors. In turn when we refer these checks to the chapter for help in the matter, more often than not, the chapter is unable to supply us with clarifying information, with the result that we spend much time in an effort to trace the maker of the check.

WE PLEAD WITH YOU. PLEASE DO NOT SEND INDIVIDUAL CHECKS WHETHER FOR THE JEWISH NATIONAL FUND OR ANY OTHER PROJECT. SEND US YOUR CHAPTER CHECK.

Dear Chapter President:

In accordance with the Hadassah policy of previous years, the National Office for the year 1951/52 again is refunding to each chapter a sum of 25¢ per member from National Administrative Funds.

Enclosed therefore is our check for \$ 9.- based on membership of 36.

You will be interested to note the following:

- 1) At the end of the fiscal year 1952/53, we will again refund to chapters a sum of 25¢ per member based on its September 30, 1953 membership figure at the National Office.
- 2) Thereafter, in accordance with a constitutional amendment adopted at the Convention in Detroit this past October, subventions will be discontinued for the year 1953/54, and instead the chapter will remit to the National Office \$ 2.50 per member, instead of the present sum of \$ 2.75.

PLEASE NOTE THAT THIS CHANGE WILL NOT TAKE EFFECT UNTIL OCTOBER 1, 1953.
