WHEREAS, Congregation Beth El has been in existence since 1980 and serving families from Patten to Lubec to Stonington as well as Bangor area families as congregants;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, ANGUS S. KING, JR., Governor of the State of Maine, do hereby proclaim April 27, 1996 as


