Moses Sklar, the 2nd of Akiva and Taube's 5 children, was born in 1847. In 1865, he married Hannah Cecilia Goldberg, born in 1845, also from Zuromin.

Hannah and Moses had eight children:

In the late 80's (est.), Moses killed a Cossack, was hidden by a friend and smuggled out of the country under Chana's maiden name of "Goldberg". The family settled in Bangor, near Sklar relatives in Old Town. They continued to use the name Goldberg.

In 1894 Annie, Moses and Chana's third child, married Max Franklin, of German Jewish descent. He died of influenza while Annie was pregnant with their child Lena. Moses and Chana brought up Lena for a few years when Annie, out of necessity, went to NY to find work. In 1897 Annie remarried Lewis Berger from New Jersey, who came back to Maine with her. They had nine children together, and also took Lena back into their home and raised her as their own (no one ever talked about the fact that Lena had another father!). Lewis and Annie's children include:

After Chana died in 1918, Moses remarried Julia Benjamin Nemsel from Portland; however, she did not stay with him very long.
