## Lawrence I. Berson

Lawrence I. Berson died after a long illness on Monday, May 28, at Eastern Maine Medical Center in Bangor, Maine. He was 80.

Born in Bangor, Mr. Berson lived most of his life there. He was the sales manager at Penobscot Poultry Company of Belfast, Maine, for 34 years, until his retirement in 1985.
