Philip Silverman, 89, had early yesterday morning at the Hebrew Home for the Aged, Portland. He had been a Lewiston resident 65 years and was one of the early Jewish settlers.

Mr. Silverman was born in Lithuania, the son of Mr. and Mrs. Mordecai Silverman, and came to this country in 1891. He had been a Lewiston merchant many years until his retirement 10 years ago. He was a member of Beth Jacob Synagog.

Surviving are a daughter, Mrs. Nathan Benson of Lewiston; two sons, Benjamin and Ernest of Lewiston; one brother, Louis of Lewiston; seven grandchildren; and four great-grandchildren.
