Last month "Materials for Palestine" asked the New England Hadassah Region to supervise a knitting project for the Israeli Army. The response by Jewish Women's Organizations was prompt and enthusiastic.

Seven hundred pounds of yarn at \$1.75 per pound were bought and distributed, and the finished articles-- gloves and mufflers -- are being shipped as rapidly as they come in. We have also made arrangements with a factory to have socks knitted at twenty cents (20¢) per pair. More yarn for socks is on order and this too, will find eager workers.

We made these purchases confident that organizations such as yours, would make a contribution to help pay the amount due. We ask you to send any sum you can spare for this project. Please mail check to:
