Dear Mrs. Slosberg:

This will acknowledge receipt of your checks in the sums of \$50.00 on behalf of Youth Aliyah and \$29.00 for your dues.

It is with deep pleasure that we note that you have now completed your Youth Aliyah commitment for 1948-49. Your achievement in reaching this goal so early is indicative of your understanding of the tremendous need for money to support this great unprecedented monthly immigration of from 1500 to 2000 children. A minimum of 15,000 children is expected to arrive in Israel this year. However, from all indications this number will be far exceeded, and it is confidently expected that closer to 20,000 will find a haven this year. Israel is happy to welcome these youngsters and has the right to expect generous and wholehearted support from the rest of the world to assure the proper reception of these children who are coming home at last to security and loving concern for their welfare.

You are probably aware of the Youth Aliyah Housing Project, initiated at the November convention in Atlantic City. We hope that your chapter is as enthusiastic as other chapters throughout the country in being represented on a housing unit for Youth Aliyah in Israel. As you know, after all quotas are raised, this extra effort will make it possible to properly house the many new children expected within the movement, and at the same time, it will be possible to attach the name of your chapter to a specific housing unit in the country. Our publication HEADLINES in January and February carried the story in detail.

Even though your quota is completed, we are confident you will continue your efforts for Youth Aliyah in order to help ease the strain on our already overburdened project. Again our warmest thanks for your constant understanding and ceaseless cooperation.
