

BATH'S JEWS.

Bath rejoices in a population of about 60 Jews there being here 18 families that form the Bath synagogue. During the Jewish New Years celebration from sunset Sunday to sunset Tuesday families from Wiscasset and Brunswick attended.

Next week Tuesday at sunset begins the chief holiday of the Jewish year, the 24 hours fast, the day of Atonement. During the 24 hours nothing must pass the lips of the strictly orthodox Jew. He must not even drink water or smoke.

Religious service will begin in the Bath synagogue Wednesday morning at sunrise and with prayer and chanting and reading of scripture the entire day will be spent.
