

CLUB TO PROMOTE DEFENSE BUYING

Men Members of Beth Israel Synagogue Form an Organization

A club to promote the sale of U. S. Defense Bonds was organized under the direction of Samuel Praver, president of the Men's Congregation of Beth Israel Synagogue, at a meeting Tuesday of last week in the vestry. Mr. Praver was named by Dr. Clinton A. Clauson, head of the state organization for the sale of Defense Bonds, to assist in the work of increasing the sales of these bonds. At Tuesday night's meeting 21 members joined a club similar to that in the welding department of the Bath Iron Works Corp., and in other organizations of the city, with the regular award of a bond to a club member. The first to receive a bond in the club organized Tuesday was Morris M. Petlock, and it was announced that at the next meeting and at succeeding meetings, two bonds would be awarded. Every member of the club will receive a bond, the name of each recipient being withdrawn from competition upon receipt of the award.
