

## MRS ANNIE MIKELSKY

### Widow of Louis Mikelsky Was Oldest Jewish Resident of Bath

Annie Milkelsky, 88, widow of Louis Mikelsky, died early Friday morning at her home, 897 Middle street, following an illness of five weeks, which confined her to her bed, although she had been in failing health for the last three years.

Mrs. Mikelsky was born in Germany, daughter of Herman and Helena (Mikaels) Simon, Oct. 8, 1857. She came to this country as a young woman and has made Bath her home for 57 years.

She was the oldest Jewish resident of Bath and the oldest member of the Beth Israel congregation and of the Hebrew Ladies Society of the church.

Surviving are one son, Charles Mikels of this city; three daughters, Miss Pauline Mikelsky, Mrs. Charles Ginsburg of Bath, and Mrs. Max Cohen of Albany, N. Y.; one grandson, Pfc. Louis H. Ginsburg, USA, stationed with the occupational forces in Japan.

Funeral services were Sunday afternoon at two o'clock from the Stanetsky's Funeral Home, 10 Washington street, Dorchester, Mass. Burial took place in the family lot in Mt. Baldwin Place cemetery, Dorchester.
