Long Time Resident Of Bath Dies Following a Long Illness

Abraham Miller died at his home, 107 Lincoln street, Monday afternoon, following a long illness. Mr. Miller was born in Russia 77 years ago, leaving his native country when a lad of 16, to come to the United States. He found employment in Boston and in 1900 came to Bath to make his permanent home.

For many years Mr. Miller conducted a painting and papering business and in connection with that he had several small grocery stores in various parts of the city. Due to ill health he retired from active duties two years ago.

He is a charter member of Beth Israel synagogue and a constant attendant as long as his health would permit.

Mr. Miller is survived by five daughters, Mrs. Eva Goldman of Malden, Mass.; Miss Sadie Miller, Mrs. Jennie Lait, Mrs. Estelle Rines, Mrs. Dorice Levine of Bath; three sons, Arthur of Brooklyn, N. Y.; Alex of Portland, and J. Lewis Miller of Bath. He is also survived by three grandsons, two granddaughters, one great-grandson and one great-granddaughter. Mrs. Miller died more than a year ago.

Funeral was Tuesday morning at 11 o'clock from the Bockstein funeral home in Portland and burial was in the family lot in Mt. Siani cemetery, Portland.
