Wife of Solomon Greenblatt Dies Suddenly

Mrs. Goldie M. Greenblatt, 64, wife of Solomon K. Greenblatt, died suddenly Tuesday night at her home, 233 Washington street.

She was born in Lithuania, Sept. 18, 1889, a daughter of Abbe and Riva Mathewson Kycet-sky. She came to America about 47 years ago and in 1907 married Mr. Greenblatt in Boston and made her home there until the family moved to Bath 39 years ago. She was well known here and had a wide circle of friends. A charter member and active in Beth Israel Synagogue in Bath, Mrs. Greenblatt was also a member of numerous charitable organizations.

Surviving, in addition to her husband, are four daughters, Mrs. Morton Berman of Eastport; Mrs. Saul Levine of Brooklyn, N. Y.; Mrs. Isadore Singer and Miss Ada Y. Greenblatt of Bath; three sons, Owen Greenblatt, an Air Force cadet at San Antonio, Texas; Isear W. Greenblat and Abraham E., of Bath; a sister, Mrs. Sam Levine, of Boston and eight grandchildren.

Services were at the Beth Israel synagogue at noon today and the funeral will take place in Portland Thursday, time pending on the arrival of her son, Owen, from San Antonio.
