

Lists Bath Churches

Taking Part In Clothing For Hungary Drive

A partial list of the Bath churches participating in the Clothing for Hungary drive was announced last week by members of the local Red Cross coordinating committee.

Participating in the project are Central Congregational church, Wesley Methodist church, Beth Israel Synagogue, Church of the New Jerusalem, Grace Episcopal church and members of the First Church of Christ Scientist.

These churches will appoint their own committees to solicit and collect clothing to be delivered by them to Winter Street church at 2 p. m. Sunday, Jan. 6. Each church will send a committee of three to assist in packing the clothing for shipment to the Church World Service in New York. Shipping costs will be paid by the Bath chapter, American Red Cross.

Committee members announced today that any kind of warm Winter clothing, with the exception of shoes, is urgently needed. They reported that most homes in Hungary now have shattered windows and little or no heat. Rubber boots, overshoes and blankets are among other much needed items.

A complete list of other churches to participate in the relief project will be announced. Any church not yet contacted by the committee is asked to notify the Rev. Dr. Oliver W. Bell, Mrs. Melvin B. Henderson, Mrs. Oscar R. Marsh, the Rev. Craig H. Richards or Mrs. Richard R. Raven, members of the local Red Cross committee, if they wish to participate in the program.
