CHILD KILLED IN BATH.

Four-Year-Old Eva Solovich Struck by a Car—Motorman Arrested.

BATH, Me., April 15, 1899. Eva Solovich, the 4-year-old daughter of Joseph Solovich, was killed by a car on the Lewiston, Brunswick & Bath street railway tonight. This is the first fatal accident which has occurred on this road.

Motorman Charles Miller, whose home is in Lisbon, was placed under arrest to await the result of the inquest, which will be held tomorrow.
