The Senior Citizen Friendship Club was organized in 1964 under the leadership of Center Director, David Shuer; with an Advisory Committee made up of the following volunteers: Miriam Viner and Ida Co-Chairmen, Fauls Adelman, Arlene Rosen, Arline Keith, Freda Miller. The women worked diligently to get people interested. Phone calls were made to every senior in our Jewish community to tell them personally of our plans to organize. The idea did not catch on too well. The name Senior Citizen was quite new and many people did not care to admit they had reached that age. The Freindship Club was one of the first clubs in the Penobecot Area.

Our Charter members were: Louis and Julia Saltzman, Sarah Rosen, Sadie Share, Nettie Shapiro, Ida Shur, Ethel Rapaport, Jennie Rubin, Ann Shafmaster, Anna Eptsein, Sam Segal, Abe Colden, Shirley Berman, Jennie Price, Lena and Jacob Braveman, Cheva Gcos, Blooma Cooperstein, Fannie Flax, and Ida Marco.

At the first meeting the following officers were elected: Louis Saltzman, President and Treasurer Abe Golden, Vice-President Ann Shafmaster, Secretary

The volunteers acted as telephone committee. Members were called before each meeting. This personal touch has been continued through the years. The young volunteers were also a transportation unit. Each member was picked up at his home and brought to the Center. They met once a month. This little group showed the real spirit of love and friendship. They visited the sick, took food to the State Hospital; for the special Holidays, the members prepared a real Passover meal for the patients. They invited other non-Jewish groups to be their guests at the meeting and showed them how beautiful our Holidays could be. To raise a little money they had food sales, card parties, and raffles. Arline Keith helped with programming and they were most appreciative of her efforts. they had speakers, musical programs, took short trips, had picnics, attended musicals at the University, the Russian Chorus at Feakes. The first big trip was a trip to Lakewood to see Gertrude Berg and a picnic supper on the way home.

The second year, we had a Senior Citizen Fashion Show. Clothes were given by Freeses and Arline Keith was narrator. The first year, it was a fun thing; after that, it became an annual affair open to the public and the money earned was given to aid in the Center Drive. We were the first senior group in the State to have a fashion show.

Through the generosity of Faula and David Adelman, the group was invited to a Barbeque. It was the highlight of the season. We had about thirty people. This has become an annual affair and now we have anywhere from 75 to 100 people and Paula is still baking kugels and David leaves his job to come home and make the hamburgers and hot dogs. What a couple!
