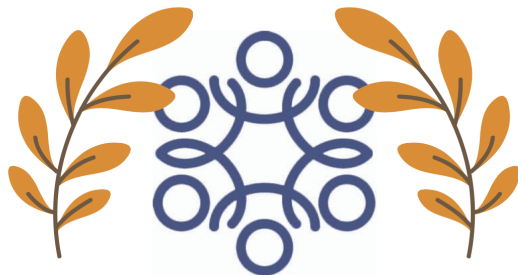


Guide to Southern Maine High Holiday Services 2020/5781
