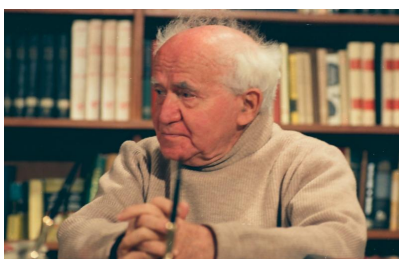
MJFF AND THE PMA PRESENT *LOVE, GILDA*
