From the Center for Small Town Jewish Life: Is Discrimination on the Basis of Educational Status Dividing our Country?

One of the greatest political and cultural fault lines in America today is the divide between those with and without a college degree. The attainment of a four-year degree (and in particular, those awarded from elite institutions) not only shapes the way in which citizens perceive the world, but also the ways in which individuals are perceived by fellow citizens, potential employers, and those who wield cultural influence and political power.

In light of the political developments over the past four years, we will discuss the nature and impact of educational status discrimination, and the ways in which rewards granted for actual or perceived merit in the current American system has shaped this moment.
