When our rabbinic ancestors read the Torah they wrote hundreds of additional stories to dive deeper and learn more about ourselves, the world, and God. We call these stories *Midrash*. Together, we will explore some of these *midrashim* as a way to understand sacred storytelling, and then craft our own *midrashim* using Jewish text, creative writing, and acting exercises. Well conclude with some dramatic readings of our stories.
