Author Ross Baker to Speak on The Party Crashers:Presidents who Remade Their Political Power

On Monday, August 6 at 7:00 p.m., Ross Baker, professor of political science at Rutgers University will speak about the political parties and those presidents and candidates who have redefined their parties throughout US history. He calls these individuals The Party Crashers. He intends to explore the prospects for the Republican Party under President Trump and the possibility that he may triangulate his own party and do deals with the Democrats.

Ross K. Baker received his B.A., M.A., and Ph.D. from the University of Pennsylvania. He was a research Associate at the Brookings Institution before joining the Rutgers faculty. Professor Bakers fields of interest are: American Government and U.S. Legislative Politics.
