- 9 wooden clothespins
- 1 piece of cardboard about the size of a sheet of paper
- 1 piece of yellow construction paper
- 1 pair of scissors
- double-sided tape
- a pen
- markers or paint to for decorating

Latke Recipe for Wednesday

To cook latkes with Max and Tessa on Wednesday, here is what you'll need:

- 1 1/2 pounds baking potatoes (3 to 4 potatoes)
- 1/2 medium yellow onion, peeled and quartered
- 1 large egg
- 2 tablespoons matzo meal or unseasoned dry breadcrumbs
- 1 teaspoon kosher salt
- 1/8 teaspoon freshly ground black pepper
- 1 cup canola oil or chicken schmaltz, or a combination of both
- applesauce and sour cream, for serving
- mixing bowl, mixing spoon, grater, frying pan, spatula
