Tu B'Shevat Community Seder

Wednesday, January 27, 5:30-6:30 p.m.

Celebrate the New Year of the Trees! Join us online for a Tu B'Shevat seder filled with delicious fruits as we look forward to spring together.

Here's what you might like to have on your seder table:

During the seder we combine light-colored and dark-colored juice or wine. You can use white or purple grape juice, or a combination!

During the seder we'll taste four different types of fruit:

- Fruit with an inedible outer layer that is edible inside, such as melons, nuts, pomegranates, coconuts, citrus, bananas, etc.
- Fruit that is edible outside but is inedible or has a pit inside: dates, olives, plums, peaches, apples, avocados, nectarines, pears, etc.
- Fruit that is entirely edible: berries, figs, grapes, etc.
- Fruit that is best enjoyed for its scent only (not for eating): cinnamon sticks, etc.

During the seder we'll also plant seeds. Please have ready a container, potting soil, and the seeds of your choice. Some people like to plant parsley for the Passover seder!
