Directions to Aroneau Camp on Alford Lake:

From Rockland and points south:

Take Route 17 West; turn right at Rte. 235 North (Buzzell Hill Road), follow 235 about two miles, down a steep hill and up again. Near the top of the hill, turn right onto dirt road (Beaver Lodge Road) at large Beaver Lodge sign.

Take first right (Colonel Lane) and continue about half a mile, always bearing right, past Laughing Waters Lane, across small field with lake visible on your left, back into woods. Road ends shortly at our camp, dividing into three drives, marked 122 and 124. Our cars will be parked straight ahead. Take the left drive (Marked 122) down to the lake cottage, where there is room for about eight cars.

From Camden and points north:

Take Rte. 105 to Hope Center, turn left at Rte. 235 South (opposite Hope General Store), drive about ten minutes; about a mile beyond sharp left turn, turn left onto Beaver Lodge Road (large sign is facing away from you; use large yellow "Hidden Drive" road sign on your right as a marker), follow directions above.

From Waldoboro and points south:

Take Rte. 235 North from Route 1 (just beyond Moody's). Turn right onto Rte. 17 and follow for a few minutes, turn left at Rte. 235 North and follow directions above.

PARKING

Our cars will be parked straight ahead where the road divides into three. There is room there for a couple of additional cars. You can also park in the middle drive, toward the yellow bungalow. Its a short walk down to the lake cottage. Please do not park on the upper lawn.
