### **Kibbutz to Farm Presentation -Sunday, May 21 - 4 p.m.**

Eitan and Elizabeth Siegel met while attending a 5 month program at Kibbutz Ramat Yohanan near Haifa, Israel. Two years later they began their farming journey. They now own and operate Heritage Home Farm, a MOFGA certified organic farm in Appleton, Maine, specializing in heirloom produce from around the world, with many varieties from the Middle East, where their ancestors originated. They will share their experience living and working on a modern Israeli kibbutz and how it lead them to run a farm in rural Maine. Eitan and Elizabeth will also discuss the CSA (Community Supported Agriculture) model - and how it relates to the kibbutz model, while sharing information about the CSA shares that they currently offer at Heritage Home Farm.

Elizabeth and Eitan will be joined by Hannah Court from Wandering Root Farm.

Hannah Court is enrolled in the MOFGA Journeyperson Program (2015-2016). Hannah was raised in Vermont and after graduating from the University of Vermont, she wandered the world looking for inspiration within herself. While looking, she unexpectedly found her meaning through farming. Since then she has farmed in New Mexico, Vermont and finally in Maine during her apprenticeship at Hatchet Cove Farm. As a tribute to her farming journey she decided on the name Wandering Root Farm. At the Morris Farm in Wiscasset, she is growing diversified vegetables and livestock with a focus on seed saving, herbs (medicinal and culinary) and education. Her long-term goal is to establish a full diet, year round CSA.

This promises to be a fascinating look at local agriculture and young farmers.Refreshments will be served.
