### **An Evening with Rachel Back**

Israeli poet and peace activist [Rachel Back](#) will be at Adas Yoshuron on Saturday, Nov. 19, at 5 p.m. to speak about "A Meeting of the Dispossessed & Possessors: A Galilean Tale."

In her talk, Professor Back will discuss a single tale of mutual recognition and reconciliation between a small group of Galilean Jews and Arabs, and what might be learned from it.

Rachel Tzvia Back is a poet, translator, professor of literature, and peace activist. She resides in the Galilee, where her great-great-great-grandfather settled in the 1830s. Her residency in Maine is co-sponsored by the Colby College Jewish Studies Program, the Center for Small Town Jewish Life, and synagogues across the state.

The evening begins at 5 p.m. with a short Havdalah service, followed by the talk, and then a Community Dinner. The dinner is by donation only, but RSVPs are necessary for the meal.
