## Race At Critical Stage

The Jewish Community Center Volleyball League enters its fifth week of competition tonight with the No. 1 and 2 teams meeting in one three-game match and with a third place tie to be broken in the other series. B'Nai B'Rith, with a record of 11-1, takes on Central Maine Power (9-3) in the crucial battle of contenders, and Belgrade Shoe faces the Center variety, each maintaining 2-8 marks.

The contests are open to the public and proceed weekly each

Wednesday evening. The B'Nai B'Rith duel is at 7 o'clock and the second encounter at 8:30 p.m.

Leaguers will continue in the first half race through Jan. 9, and then go through a second half schedule concluding April 10. In all they play through seven full rounds.

Al Rakofsky, sports director at the Center, said the league is aiming to send an entry to a State open championship tentatively planned this spring to supplement the State Y tourney customarily conducted.
