GENERAL NOTES ON SHALIT:

Boston Herald, 12 December 1977 by P. Albert Duhamel: In similar Fashion the name "Shalit" is really a whole salutation, an acronym for a phrase commonly used to follow the name of a distiguished person to whom a letter was addressed. Following his name, the phrase, "sheyihe leorekh yamin tovim" was added for it meant "may he live long and good days." Reduced to an acronym, as in the name of Gene Shalit, one of the hosts on the television "Today" program, it means the same thing.

Obit - David Shalit Passes Away - David H. Shalit died last Sunday morning at his home, 17 Crawford street, Roxbury, at the age of sixty-nine years. Mr. Shalit was a member of Congregation Mishkan Tefila, Hebrew Free Loan Society and Tifereth Israel Society. He is survived by his widow, two sons, Bernard and L. Melville; two daughters, Mrs. A. A. Golden and Mrs. Manuel V. Albert, all of Boston; one sister, Mrs. Levenson of Dorchester; two brothers, Henry Shalit of Salem and Abraham Shalit of Sanford, Me.

Family remembrances: Born in Russian Poland in the town of Simna, the oldest of five sons, David fled to Germany to avoid service in the army (by law the duty of the eldest boy). There he worked as a peddler. His mother would sneak across the border to see him and on one such trip, fell and injured herself fatally.

David came to Boston and then to Maine to see Isaac Abrams, a friend of his family and a neighbor from a nearby Polish village. There he met and became engaged to Etta Abrams. He married her and returned to Boston in 1889. He started a men's shop in Lawrence, MA and assisted his wife in establishing the blouse business. David retired to Roxbury, MA and later Dorchester, MA, when Edith married.
